



## DSV named official logistics partner of Porsche Motorsport North America

11/02/2026 Sponsorship agreement will add branding to PCCNA paddock in 2026 season.

Carson, Calif. Porsche Motorsport North America (PMNA) has named global transport and logistics experts DSV the Official Logistics Partner of PMNA for the 2026 season.

DSV, a global transport and logistics provider with nearly 150,000 employees in 90 countries worldwide, transported the new Porsche 911 Cup cars from Germany to the United States to race in Porsche Carrera Cup North America in time for the 2026 season. The premier North American Porsche One-Make series is one of just four series world-wide, including Porsche Mobil 1 Supercup, Porsche Carrera Cup Germany, and Porsche Carrera Cup Asia, using the new 992.2-generation car in the upcoming season.

DSV branding will appear on all Porsche Carrera Cup North America race cars during the season.

"We can't thank DSV enough for their work to safely deliver our new Porsche 911 Cup race cars in the new year," Volker Holzmeyer, President and CEO of Porsche Motorsport North America, said. "Aligning PMNA with DSV provides an opportunity, not only for us, but for our customers who race around the world."

DSV collected new Porsche 911 Cup cars from Germany in December to begin the process of moving them to the United States. Once they cleared customs, cars were distributed to customer teams in time for a series-wide test session at Sebring International Raceway, February 16-17, ahead of the season opener at the same track, March 18-20.

"Timing and planning are just as important in motorsports as they are in logistics," Sven Diefenbacher, Vice President of Automotive Americas from DSV said. "We're proud to combine our global efforts with Porsche Motorsport North America to work together on all of their logistical and transport needs and be a part of the upcoming Porsche Carrera Cup North America season."

Porsche Carrera Cup North America opens its sixth season in 2026. Last season, Ryan Yardley (New Zealand) joined previous champions Sebastian Priaulx (Great Britain), Parker Thompson (Canada), Riley Dickinson (New Braunfels, Texas), and Loek Hartog (Netherlands) in earning the overall championship.
